CHS/J23 announces its first “Read-Together”
for the summer of 2008.

We have chosen a book that we want everyone in the CHS/J23 community to read. Our goals are to encourage students to become lifelong readers and to provide an opportunity for students and families to have stimulating conversations about a piece of literature.

Here’s how it works:

The Book Thief by Markus Zusak
is this year’s selection.

(“It’s just a small story really, about among other things: a girl, some words, an accordionist, some fanatical Germans, a Jewish fistfighter, and quite a lot of thievery.....”)

1. You may borrow a copy from the Main Office to read.
2. You may purchase a copy from the local bookstore (\$11.99)
3. Pick up a discussion guide at the Main Office or access it through our website.
4. Students may choose to do a project based on the book.
5. Students/parents will be invited to a breakfast or lunch event in the fall so that we can talk about our reactions to the book. If students choose to complete a project related to the book, they can share those at that time.
